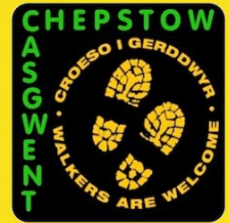


# Chepstow Walking Festival 2019

## St Arvans roundabout



There are several walks that we just can't leave out and this is one of them. The start point is easy to reach from Chepstow and no matter how many times you walk this route it never fails to please. The route takes in the "picturesque" Piercefield woods before climbing to Gaer Hill camp with spectacular views over the Severn Estuary.

**This walk is not suitable for dogs**

**Distance:** 5 miles

**Time:** Between 3—4 hours

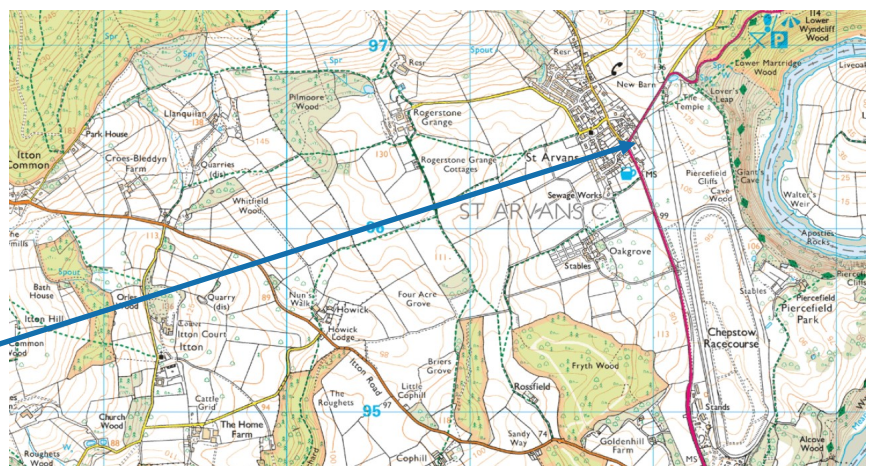
**Difficulty:** Moderate

**Meeting Point:** St Arvans fountain (junction of A466 and Devauden Road)

**What to bring:** Drinks, snacks and a camera

**Bus option:** Take the 10:20am No 69 bus from Chepstow bus station and alight at St Arvans

**Parking:** Free at St Arvans Village Hall car park, off the A466 just past the Devauden turning.
