### The Gwent Levels from Above



Join the Living Levels Partnership in celebrating the juxtaposition of the Gwent Levels, by discovering more about its industrial development via this small walk with a big pay-off! Following the Wales Coast Path from Newport Wetlands, taking in such contrasting features as the East Usk Lighthouse, St. Mary's Church in Nash and Newport Docks. The route culminates in a birds-eye view of this unique landscape from the iconic Newport Transporter Bridge (weather permitting)! For those not fancying the walk over the bridge, a more sedate crossing of the River Usk is possible via the gondola. After visiting the historic Waterloo Hotel there is the option to stay there for lunch or return to Newport Wetlands.
