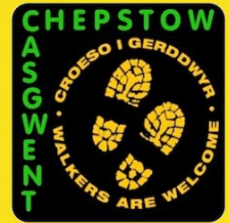

A bus will take us to Nash Church from where we start our walk back to Magor. On the way we will visit Nash Church and those at Goldcliff, Whitson, Redwick and Magor. We will also have a representative from the Living Levels Partnership who will explain how the levels work and their history. For those interested we will also be looking out for the birds that live on the levels including, if we are very lucky, cranes. The walk is flat and takes us across fields and some of the lanes that make the levels unique.

This walk is not suitable for dogs

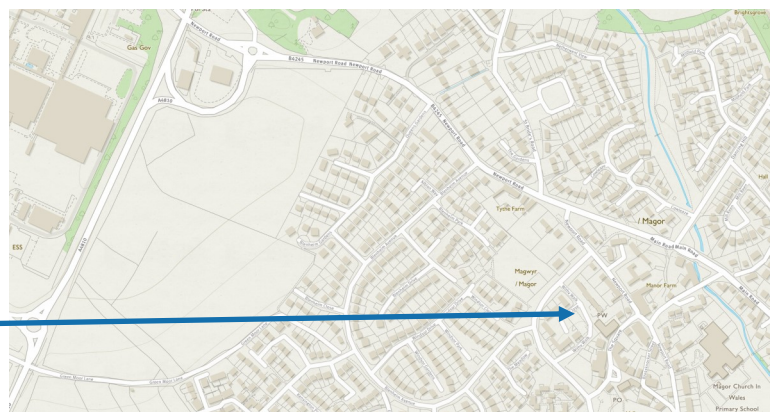
Distance: 7 miles (linear, transport to start provided by the Living Levels Partnership)
