Western Approaches to Trellech



Based on 'Lower Wye Rambles' ramble 6, this is a stunning walk through fields and woods to the west of Trellech. Wonderful views of the Black Mountains and woodland wildflowers on the way before returning via Wetmeadow Wood to St Nicholas Church, where we will be treated to a demonstration of bellringing and a chance to visit the bell tower. After the walk the locally renowned Trellech Teas will be open for refreshments at the Babington Centre.

This walk is not suitable for dogs

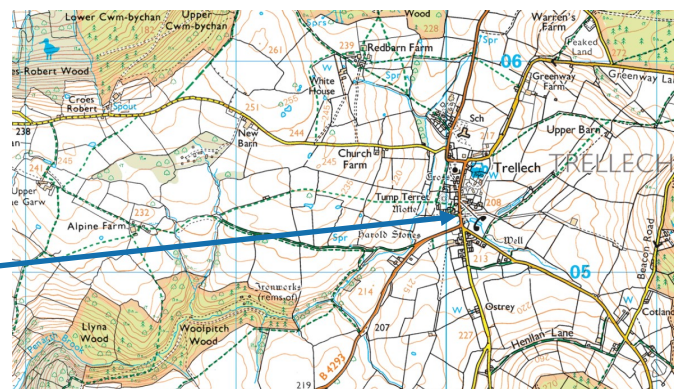
Distance: 5.5 miles (circular)
