The Resistance Walk



This walk retraces the footsteps of one of the Special Auxiliary Units (Jonah Patrol) created by Winston Churchill as one of the secret guerrilla groups designed to operate behind enemy lines. The walk starts in Wentwood and meanders through the forest to the remains of the secret underground bunkers now protected as an ancient monument. Glorious views to the Severn Estuary as we go.

Distance: 7.5 miles (circular)

Time: Allow 4 hours

Difficulty: Moderate
