The Bream Heritage Walk



This walk highlights the heritage of Bream and illustrates the industries which thrived here and throughout the Forest of Dean - iron and coal, quarrying and forestry. Skirting around Bream eventually brings us to China Bottom and the Oakwood Valley where David Mushet famous for steel processing worked his own mine and tramroad. An interesting and variable landscape.
