Three Castles and Three Murders



This is a delightful walk starting in The St Bride's Valley. The walk is steeped in history with 3 castles, the remains of the oldest dating back to at least AD 160. You will also pass the site of three murders, from the 5th century to modern times, and there are fabulous views across the Severn Estuary and to both Severn bridges. Option to eat at the Rock and Fountain on our return.

This walk is not suitable for dogs

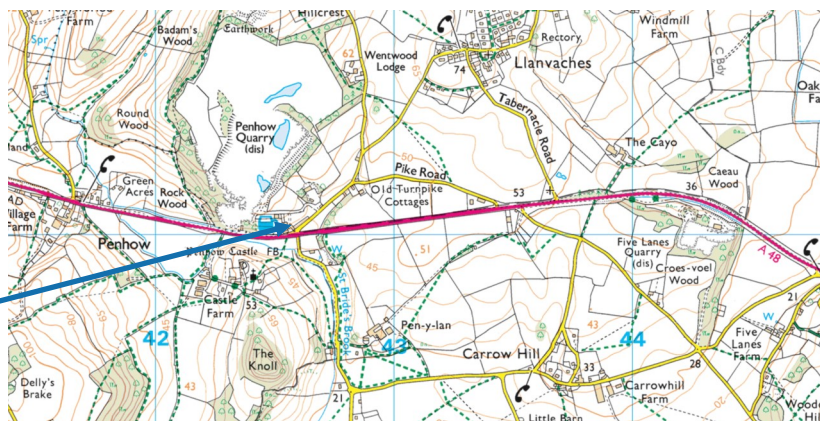
Distance: 9 miles (circular)
