Clytha and Bettws Newydd with Bluebells Galore!



This walk offers stunning views across the Usk Valley and beyond to the Brecon Beacons. The route takes in part of the Usk Valley Walk alongside the river Usk, the lovely hamlet of Bettws Newydd with its stunning church, an Iron Age Hill fort with probably the best display of bluebells you will see in Monmouthshire, and a folly.

This walk is suitable for dogs on leads - opportunities for well-behaved dogs to walk off lead

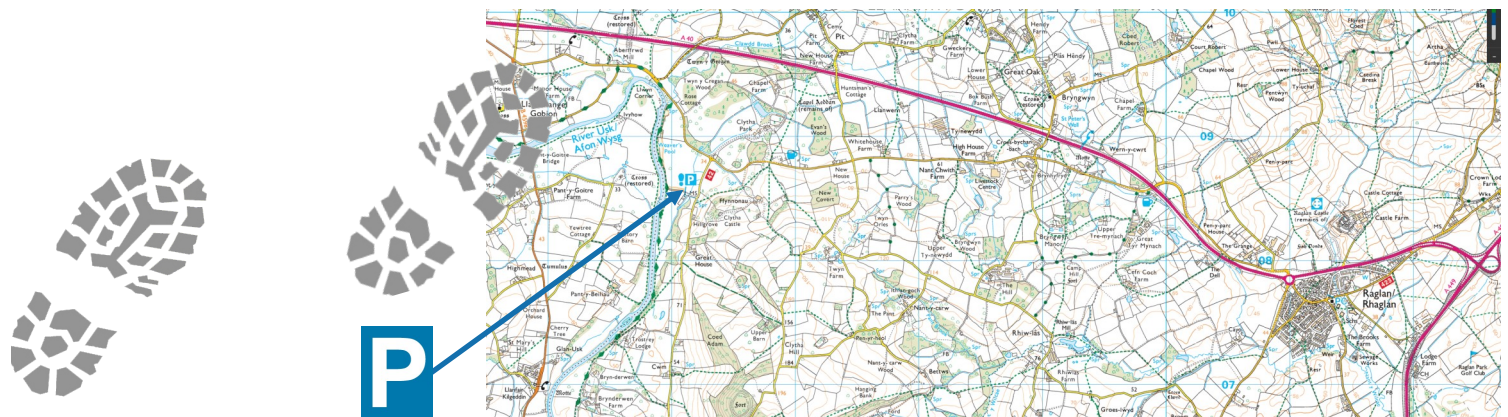
Distance: 6 miles (circular)

Time: Allow 3 hours

Difficulty: Moderate with some ascent and stiles

Meeting Point and Parking: SO361085 Clytha riverside car park, Clytha Estate NP7 9BW. From the A40 roundabout at Raglan take the exit signed Clytha, after 3.3 miles (just after the Clytha Arms) turn left signed Clytha car park, then after 0.2 miles turn right into the car park.

Bring: Picnic, drinks and a camera
